



Wellington Family Speedway – Club Season Points

Overview

Club points are accumulated throughout the race season, with points from each eligible race meeting contributing to a driver's season total. This system rewards consistency and participation across the full calendar.

Points Assignment

Club points are assigned to the registered **car number**, not the driver. If a driver uses another competitor's vehicle during a meeting, points will be credited to the car they drove, not to their personal total. If a driver changes their car or racing number during the season, they must notify the club before the meeting. Failure to do so may result in points being incorrectly attributed or lost.

Points Calculation

Wellington Speedway calculates points based on the **maximum field size** allowed for each class under Speedway New Zealand guidelines, regardless of how many cars are actually on track during a particular race meeting. The maximum field sizes (thus maximum points per race) are as follows:

- Superstocks: 26
- Stockcars: 30
- Streetstocks: 26
- Ministocks: 30
- Modifieds: 20
- Saloons: 20
- TQ Midgets: 20
- Production Saloons: 20

It is important to note that **Speedhive results should not be used to track Wellington club points**. Speedhive reflects points based on the number of cars on track at a given meeting and does not account for disqualifications, relegations, or the club's maximum field point system.

Non-Points Events

Not all events contribute to club points. The following types of events or circumstances will not carry points toward the club championship:

- Meetings designated as non-points rounds (these will be communicated in advance) such as club nights.
- National titles including NZ Championships, Grand Prix events, and North Island Championships (both when hosted at Wellington and when being held at another track on a given night).
- Special events such as the Stockcar Ultimate Knockout.
- The NZ Stockcar Teams Championship weekend (no Stockcar points awarded).
- At the club's discretion, Stockcar team drivers may have their season points aggregated when away competing for national titles or the class may not have points for the weekend.



Additionally, Stockcars do not run points during the Wellington Championship. Other contact classes will be notified prior to their championship events whether points will apply.

Additional Races and Format Exceptions

Races added at the end of a meeting (e.g., “first up, best dressed” races) generally do not contribute to club points unless otherwise stated over the pit announcement system.

For events such as the Wellington Modified Championship or the Phil Patterson Memorial, only the first three heats with predetermined grids will contribute to club points. The fourth race, which is typically gridded by finishing order, will not count toward season totals. This ensures all drivers have equal opportunity to score across a consistent format.

Drop Your Worst Round

To allow for unavoidable absences or misfortunes, Wellington Speedway operates a “drop your worst round” policy. This allows each driver to have their lowest-scoring meeting or meeting they have not been able to participate in removed from their season total. Drivers who attend every round will still have their lowest scoring night deducted.

Eligibility and Access

Club points are only recorded and tracked for competitors who are **registered to Wellington Family Speedway**. Points are published and updated on the official club website under each class section: www.wellingtonspeedway.co.nz.
